We will enter phase one of the Opening city - Stay at home restrictions as per Governor Abbot's recent recommendations. The following should be adhered to as we begin to gather at **10:30 A.M. on May 10th**.

Of course if you are ill stay at home. Also, if you feel reluctant to attend because of health issues the service will at present be streamed on Facebook.

1. Social distancing will be observed---6 feet.
2. Seating—chairs in sanctuary front to back are at proper distance. Left to right there should be three empty chairs between families. To facilitate distancing--- chairs on each row should be occupied on each end of row first.
3. We will wipe down restrooms Sunday AM.
4. Restrooms:
 - a. Try and enter without using hands.
 - b. Try and use controls with back of hand.
 - c. Wash hands with soapy water for 20-25 seconds.
 - d. Upon exiting—use paper towel to open door and discard in wastebasket outside door.
 - e. There will be a limited amount of hand sanitizer on counter in JS room.
5. No coffee bar or chairs arranged in JS room to discourage congregating there.
6. No children church until further notice.
7. Sunday School will probably start about May 24.
8. Mid week service will be at discretion of Pastor.
9. No meet and greet for now.
10. Mask are recommended but not required.
11. Toys in nursery will be wiped down.
12. You might consider having some hand sanitizer in your car to use as you leave church.
